WHEREAS, storm water runoff typically drains directly, without filtration or treatment, to the nation's waterways; and

WHEREAS, nonpoint source pollutants in storm water runoff – such as pesticides, fertilizers, oils, grease and eroded soils – have been identified as the largest single source of water contamination in the nation's waterways; and

Whereas, pursuant to US Environmental Protection Agency's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System, Floyd County has implemented a Stormwater Management Program to control polluted storm water runoff; and

WHEREAS, public education and community involvement vis-à-vis the minimization and control of nonpoint runoff pollutants is an essential component of the Floyd County Stormwater Management Program; and

WHEREAS, Floyd County desires to increase public awareness of storm water runoff issues,
