

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE FCO 2008-V AND FCO 2010-XVI  
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PUBLIC HEALTH SAFEGUARDS  
FOR FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS AND BED AND BREAKFASTS  
IN FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for Floyd County, Indiana is desirous of amending the Application and Permit Fees Section:

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Board of Health voted on March 18, 2015 to amend the Application and Permit Fees Section of Ordinance FCO 2008-V and Ordinance FCO 2010-XVI as follows:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Application and Permit Fees Section of Ordinance FCO 2008-V and FCO 2010-XVI is hereby amended to read as follows:

Permit fees for Retail Food Market

≤3,000sq ft	\$125
3,001 – 10,000	\$200
10,001 – 25,000	\$250
25,001 – 50,000	\$300
50,001 – 90,000	\$375
≥90,001	\$450

Permit fees for Retail Food Service

Menu Type 1	\$175
Menu Type 2	\$225
Menu Type 3	\$275
Menu Type 4	\$325
Menu Type 5	\$400

Permit fees for Temporary Food Establishments

Temporary Permits \$20 per day, not to exceed \$100, for a maximum of 14 days

Flat rate Permit fees:

Bed and Breakfast	\$150
Retail Food Establishment this is a seasonal concession operating less than six (6) months per year	\$175
Mobile Retail Food Establishment	\$175
Farmers Market Permit - potentially and non-potentially hazardous foods	\$125

Pro-rated Fee per Month

Retail Food Market	\$10
≤3,000sq ft	\$16
3,001 – 10,000	\$20
10,001 – 25,000	\$25
25,001 – 50,000	\$31
50,001 – 90,000	\$37
≥90,001

Menu Type 1	\$14
Menu Type 2	\$18
Menu Type 3	\$22
Menu Type 4	\$27
Menu Type 5	\$33
