

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 1997- FCO-97-X
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOYD COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of August, 1994, and the 25th day of August, 1994, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd and the Floyd County Council, respectively, approved certain personnel policies governing conditions of employment, benefits, and related matters; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.12 of the Floyd County Personnel Policies entitled LONGEVITY PAY addresses the subject of such pay for full time employees; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd that clarification of this Section is necessary to cause same to accurately reflect the longevity pay schedule implemented by the Floyd County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of amending Section 3.12 said policies as hereinafter provided.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED that Section 3.12 of the Floyd County Personnel Policies be amended by the deletion of the term "seven" in the first sentence, and by the substitution therefor of the term "six", and further amended by the deletion therefrom of the following phrase:

Step 7.....25 years of service

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the amendment to the Floyd County Personnel Policies as set forth herein shall be in full force and effect upon the adoption by the Floyd County Council of a resolution confirming and approving same.
