

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 1997-FCO-IX

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PUBLIC PLACE OR WAY

WHEREAS, a petition for the vacation of a public place or way, pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-7-3-12, has been filed with the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd; and

WHEREAS, due notice of the filing of such petition was given as required by the provisions of IC 36-7-3-12(c); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice, a public hearing was held on the petition on the 19th day of August, 1997, and no person spoke in opposition to the proposed vacation.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that the following described public place or way or portion thereof, to-wit:

Vacating a public right of way known as Hickory Drive between Lot Number 28 and Lot Number 29 of Plat Number 794, said plat better known as Wymberly Woods, Lafayette Township be, and the same hereby is, vacated as such vacation is expressly authorized by the provisions of IC 33-3-7-12(e), also subject to a 10foot utility easement along the South end of said 50ft strip

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the vacation of the public place or way described in this ordinance shall be subject to the rights of any public utility presently using all or any part of said public place or way.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that copies of this ordinance shall be delivered to the Recorder of Floyd County for recording and to Floyd County Auditor as required by IC 36-3-7-12(f).
