

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 1999-IV

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NON-REVERTING FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING A DRUG TESTING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Judge of the Floyd Superior Court is desirous of implementing a Drug Testing Program to be funded by a fee to be assessed for the testing procedure; and

WHEREAS, the implementation of the program will require the creation of a non-reverting fund into which collected fees shall be deposited and from which incurred expenses shall be paid; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Accounts has confirmed in Volume No. 283 of The County Bulletin, January, 1991, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, acting pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-3, et seq., is empowered to create, by ordinance, such funds deemed necessary for the effective operation of government as to local affairs.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED that a non-reverting fund, to be know as the Superior Court Drug Testing Fund, be, and the same hereby is created, with said fund to subject to the following terms and provisions:

- (1) REVENUE: Fees collected by the Superior Court Probation Office for the administration of in-office drug testing shall be deposited in the fund, and the Judge of the Floyd Superior Court shall be empowered to request, from time to time, that the Floyd County Council appropriate from the County General Fund, and/or transfer from one or more categories of the Superior Court/Probation Office budget(s), such amounts as shall be reasonably necessary to effect the purposes for which the fund was created.
- (2) PURPOSE: The purpose of the fund is to enable the Floyd Superior Court Probation Office to implement an in-office drug testing program, with the proceeds of the fund to be used to purchase and replenish drug testing supplies and equipment and to pay the costs of verification of positive test results.
