

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2003-XVIII

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NON-REVERTING FUND FOR THE  
FLOYD COUNTY COURT

WHEREAS, the Judge of the Floyd County Court has implemented and Alcohol and Drug Program for Floyd County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, a recent audit of this program by the Indiana State Administrator of the Court Alcohol and Drug Program has resulted in the recommendation that present Alcohol and Drug non-reverting fund be used exclusively for the deposit of fees received by the Floyd County Court in connection with this program; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Court presently receives fees for services rendered in supervising those individuals performing community service as a part of a sentence or other judicial disposition imposed by the Court for non-alcohol related offenses, and the Court is desirous of causing these fees to be deposited in a separate non-reverting fund; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Accounts has confirmed in Volume No. 283 of the County Bulletin, January, 1991, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, acting pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-3, et seq., is empowered to create, by ordinance, such funds deemed necessary for the effective operation of government as to local affairs.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED that a non-reverting fund, to be known as the Floyd County Court Community Service Fund be, and the same hereby is created, with said fund to be subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) REVENUE: Fees collected by the Floyd County Court for the supervision of non-drug related community service shall be deposited in the fund, and the Judge of the Floyd County Court shall be empowered to request, from time to time, that the Floyd County Council appropriate from the County General Fund and/or transfer such amounts as shall be reasonably necessary to effect the purposes for which fund was created.
- (2) APPROPRIATION: All monies expended from the fund shall be subject to appropriation by the Floyd County Council.

(4) NON-REVERSION: The fund hereby created shall be non-reverting from year to year.
