FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2005- XII

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FUNDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-8-16, et seq., the Floyd County Council has established a uniform enhanced emergency telephone system fee, which fees, upon receipt, are deposited by the Floyd County Auditor in the Floyd County Emergency Telephone System Fund (Fund); and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff has requested an appropriation of \$10,000.00 from the Fund to cover overtime pay earned by persons dispatching Township fire departments, county police officers, and emergency ambulance services, all as contemplated by cited statute; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the requested appropriation is for services which constitute a necessary part of the emergency telephone system of Floyd County, Indiana, and that the funding of same is authorized by the provisions of IC 36-8-16-14; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is presently desirous of approving the request of the Sheriff and appropriating the necessary funds.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that the recitals set forth herein be, and the same hereby are, incorporated into this ordinance and made a part hereof.

BE IT ORDAINED, pursuant to the authority of IC 36-8-16-4, that a sum not to exceed \$10,000.00 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated from the Floyd County Emergency Telephone System Fund for the use by the Floyd County Sheriff to defray overtime expenses incurred in dispatching emergency response units and vehicles within said County.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage.
