FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2005- XVIII

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FUNDS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-8-16, et seq., the Floyd County Council has established a uniform enhanced emergency telephone system fee, which fees, upon receipt, are deposited by the Floyd County Auditor in the Floyd County Emergency Telephone System Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff and chief of the New Albany Police Department have petitioned for funds necessary to provide emergency medical training to dispatch personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd has determined that the requested training directly relates to a necessary attribute of the emergency telephone system of Floyd County, Indiana, and that the funding of same is authorized by the provisions of IC 36-8-16-14; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is presently desirous of approving this request and appropriating the necessary funds.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that the recitals set forth above be incorporated into this ordinance by reference and made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a sum not to exceed \$11,000.00 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated for training services so as to enable all city and county emergency dispatch personnel to obtain required emergency medical certification.
