

FLOYD COUNTY ORDINANCE 2005- XXV

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A NON-REVERTING FUND TO BE KNOWN AS
THE FLOYD COUNTY PROSECUTOR DRUG INVESTIGATION FUND

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney for Floyd County, Indiana (Prosecutor), receives, from time to time, disbursements of funds from state and/or federal law enforcement agencies, the same representing a local share of money or property confiscated from or forfeited by drug offenders; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecutor is desirous of using these funds to enhance the ability of his office, or those of other local law enforcement agencies, to investigate drug crimes or other offences against the laws of the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Accounts has confirmed in Volume No. 283 of the County Bulletin, January, 1991, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd, acting pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-1-3, *et seq.*, is empowered to create, by ordinance, such funds deemed necessary for the effective operation of government as to local affairs.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, that the recitals set forth above be, and they hereby are, incorporated herein and made a part of this Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a non-reverting fund, to be known as the Floyd County Prosecutor Drug Investigation Fund (Fund), be, and the same hereby is created, with said fund to be subject to the following terms and conditions:

(1) **REVENUE**: the Prosecutor shall deposit in said Fund those monies received from state and federal law enforcement agencies as a local share of money or property confiscated from or forfeited by drug offenders, which deposits may be supplemented by voluntary contributions to the Fund, other law enforcement fees or forfeitures specifically designated for deposit therein, and appropriations by the Floyd County Council.

(2) **FUND PURPOSE**: The monies deposited in the Fund shall be used to aid and assist in the conduct of criminal investigations undertaken by the office of the Floyd County Prosecutor and such other law enforcement agencies as the Prosecutor shall designate, from time to time.

(3) **NON-REVERSION**: The fund hereby created shall be non-reverting from year to year.
