

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-07
ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FLOYD
COUNTY, INDIANA CREATING FLOYD COUNTY ECONOMIC
STABILIZATION AND RECOVERY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2020 the Governor of Indiana declared a public health emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak ("COVID-19") pursuant to I.C. 10-14-3-12; and


WHEREAS, the Floyd County Board of Commissioners desires to avoid the disruption of the County's economy and provide funds to help stabilize the local business community, provide needed resources for the most community's most vulnerable during this COVID-19 outbreak and establish funding for economic recovery needs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners for Floyd County, Indiana, that the creation of a Floyd County Economic Stabilization and Recovery Program is vital to the economy of the County and the well-being of its citizens. That it directs community and economic funds appropriated to the County Commissioners to be used in the development of programming that meets the goals and objectives of the program as stated in this ordinance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDINANCE by the Board of Commissioners for Floyd County, Indiana, that this Ordinance is null and void upon the expiration of the declared public health emergency or any subsequent declared national emergency related to COVID-19.


