

ORDINANCE NO. FCO-2021- 32

ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR ADMINISTRATION OF CARES ACT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Floyd County has funds from the CARES Act; and

WHEREAS, there has been designated by Floyd County a CARES Act grant fund through which such reimbursements are received; and

WHEREAS, any remaining funds should be transferred to the general fund in the budget of the Floyd County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS; it is expected that the Floyd County Council appropriate said amount for COVID under the Commissioners budget and the Commissioners would approve the claims to be against that appropriation.

WHEREAS, the process contemplated herein is intended to allow for maximum usage of these funds at the direction of the Indiana State Board of Accounts.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Floyd County Board of Commissioners, Floyd County, Indiana hereby establishes the following process in order to utilize CARES Act funding to properly pay costs:

The CARES Act grant funds shall be receipted into the general fund in an account under the control of the Commissioners, line item 1000-068.


The CARES Act funds shall be subject to appropriation by the Floyd County Council and approval of claims by the Floyd County Commissioners.
