RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of Floyd County, Indiana, request the local Congressional Delegation of the States of Kentucky and Indiana obtain resolutions by the Public Works Committees of the United State Senate and the House of Representatives, authorizing the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers to participate with the interested agencies of State and Local Governments in conducting an urban oriented Water Resources Study in the Metropolitan Region of Louisville, Kentucky, for the purpose of providing a plan for the development, utilizations, and conservation of water and related land resources.

This study may include appropriate consideration of the needs for protection against floods, wise use of flood plain lands, urban storm water disposal systems, regional water supply systems, regional waste management facilities systems, enhancement and control of water quality, general recreation facilities, enhancement and conservation of fish and wildlife, and other measures for environmental enhancement and economic development. Such plans shall be harmonious components of comprehensive development plans formulated by various planning agencies and by interested Local, State and Federal agencies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to request the local Congressional Delegation support Federal funding of such Study subsequent to its authorization by the Public Works Committees.
