WHEREAS, Mr. William A. Jaeggers, Box 34, Georgetown, Indiana, did heretofore, pursuant to Section 402, Ordinance No. 1967-2, file with the Floyd County Health Officer his Petition for an exception from the literal application of said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of January, 1977, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd conducted a hearing relative to said Petition, at which hearing both the Petitioner and the Floyd County Health Department were represented and permitted to offer evidence on the subject of the requested exception with respect to the real estate located in the County of Floyd, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The West 26 feet of Lot 15, also the East 6 feet of Lot 16 in the Town of Georgetown, Floyd County, Indiana.

WHEREAS, following the conclusion of said hearing, the Petitioner and representatives of the Floyd County Health Department consummated an agreement relative to the installation of a sewer system with respect to the real estate which was the subject of the Petitioner's request for exception, a copy of which Agreement is attached to and made a part of this Resolution; and

Jaeggers, Box 34, Georgetown, Indiana, and the New Albany-Floyd County Health Department, relative to the issuance of a sewer permit with respect to the real estate located in the County of Floyd, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

The West 26 feet of Lot 15, also the East 6 feet of Lot 16 in the Town of Georgetown, Floyd County, Indiana.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the New Albany-Floyd County Health Department be and the same hereby is, authorized and directed to issue to William A. Jaeggers a sewage permit pursuant to the provisions of Section 302, Ordinance No. 1967-2 for the construction of a sewage disposal system upon the real estate described herein and upon the conditions and stipulations stated in the Agreement made a part hereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution, together with the Agreement made a part hereof, be recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Floyd County, for the purpose of placing all persons upon notice of the contents hereof.

It is agreed between the New Albany-Floyd County Health Department and William A. Jaggers that a sewage permit will be issued on the property of Mr. William A. Jaggers, located on Highway 64, (Main Street), Georgetown, Indiana

Mr. William A. Jaggers will use a pressure sewage system, thus changing all sewage to liquid, pumping said sewage to a three thousand (3,000) gallon existing cistern. The cistern is to be conditioned to be water tight. Said cistern is to be used as a holding tank and pumped by an approved septic tank cleaner when nearly full and the effluent is to be hauled in an approved vehicle to an approved dumping site. There is to be no lateral lines connected to the cistern (holding tank). At no time is there to be more than two persons living in the house.
