RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FLOYD COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ADOPTING THE OVERALL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR FLOYD COUNTY.

WHEREAS, The Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965, as amended, provides assistance to communities to improve conditions of unemployment or underemployment and establish stable and diversified economies; and,


WHEREAS, Floyd County, Indiana is qualified to be designated as a Redevelopment Area subsequent to approval of an Overall Economic Development Program; and,
