

FLOYD COUNTY RESOLUTION 1994-VIII
A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF MAY 15 THRU MAY 22 AS
OPERATION LIFESAVER WEEK

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd acknowledges that many railway crossing accidents may be prevented by increasing public awareness of crossing dangers and by enjoining observance of appropriate driving safety rules and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd recognizes that Operation Lifesaver is the foremost program for the provision of information and programs dedicated to the prevention of railroad crossing accidents; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Floyd is desirous of designating the week of May 15 thru May 22, 1994 as Operation Lifesaver Week; encouraging participation by the citizens of Floyd County in programs designed to increase awareness of the dangers inherent in railway crossings; and, of fostering adherence to safe driving habits at all railroad crossings.


NOW THEREFORE:
