Whereas, the Board received from the Floyd County Plan Commission a favorable recommendation of the proposed text amendments listed in Exhibit A and Exhibit B.





Exhibit B – Subdivision Control Ordinance

Article II – Definitions

CONTROL POINT (TRAFFIC) means any traffic signal/sign by which traffic is alternately directed to stop and permitted to proceed.

LARGE SCALE DEVELOPMENT means a subdivision of land which creates more than 125 lots.
