WHEREAS, FLOYD COUNTY recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted all hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and


WHEREAS, FLOYD COUNTY participated jointly in the planning process with the other local units of government within the County to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the FLOYD COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, hereby adopts the FLOYD COUNTY All Hazards Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Floyd County Emergency Management Agency will submit on behalf of the participating municipalities the adopted All Hazards Mitigation Plan to the Indiana Department of Homeland Security and Federal Emergency Management Agency officials for final review and approval.


