

Floyd County Resolution 2015 II

A RESOLUTION PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY TO CLARK COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Sheriff has advised the Floyd County Board of Commissioners that one of the Sheriff's patrol vehicles are no longer needed and necessary for law enforcement purposes: and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of Clark County has indicated his desire to acquire said vehicle for use by the Clark County Sheriff's Department and has proposed the payment of the sum of \$9000.00 for the vehicle.

WHEREAS, the provisions of Indiana Code 36-1-11-8 permit the transfer of property between government entities for any amount of real property, cash or other personal property as agreed by such entities; and

WHEREAS, for the price and under the terms agreed to, the Board is desirous of transferring said vehicle to Clark Sheriff.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that upon the adoption by the Floyd County Board Commissioners the following described vehicle will be transferred to the Clark County Sheriff

2011 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor Vin# 2FABP7BV2BX136487

Upon the payment of \$9, 0000.00 to the Floyd County Sheriff for said vehicle.


