On November 21, 2018, IDEM received a remediation completion report (RCR) regarding the removal of the fly ash placed on the New Albany Impound Lot Property located at 1706 Highway 111, New Albany, Indiana.

The RCR stated that the fly ash was excavated and disposed of at the Outer Loop Landfill in Louisville, KY. Disposal manifests were included in the RCR. The excavation area was backfilled with gravel and soil from M & M Construction Materials. The report is acceptable to IDEM.
